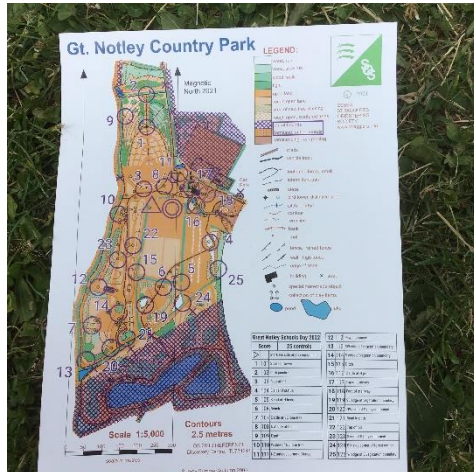
Year 5/6 Visit to Marks Hall
